The workshop will be held in at the beautiful and creative environment of The Barn which is a unique facility tucked away in the Adelaide Hills at the old homestead “Wairoa” (16 kilometres from the CBD). It is a character filled large old stone horse barn and stable which has served as an art space since 1973 when it was the art room for Marbury School.
